

## A GUIDE TO THE WOODGATE DAY CELEBRATION

**Free Pancake Breakfast** - The fun begins early! To help you wake up, join us at 8 a.m. for a cup of coffee at the Levins' house on the corner of Willow Wick and Huntington. (Tables will be set up in the street.) Then, get in line for the best pancakes in town. They're served hot and dripping with butter and syrup, sausage and orange juice.
